To the Editor,

We need your help! The 100 Deadliest Days for drivers are upon us. The summer days between Memorial Day and Labor Day weekend are when Minnesota sees the majority of serious injury and fatal crashes. These crashes do not need to happen if people make smart choices. Help keep our roads safe this summer.

In Ramsey County, between 2011 and 2015, we ranked second in the metro area for pedestrian fatalities. We also had the highest rate in the metro area for bicycle and motorcycle fatalities. In 2015 alone, Ramsey County experienced a total of 18 fatalities and 73 serious injuries due to crashes, and the preliminary numbers for 2016, while not yet finalized, are not much better.

Impaired driving, distracted driving, excessive speeds, and not wearing a seat belt continue to contribute to these fatalities and injuries, all of which are 100 nercent




# Metro Minnesota Regional Crash Data


#### Metro MN Fatalities, 2013-2017\*










### Population of Minnesota, 2015\*









### National Stop Arm Violation Count

While school buses remain the safest way for students to get to and from school, students who ride in buses are most vulnerable when they are outside the bus in the "danger zone." In 2010, NASDPTS passed a resolution initiating the first national survey to determine the prevalence of illegal passing of school buses. Using that data as a starting point, NASDPTS encourages improved safety countermeasures at the state or national level. Here is the NASDPTS Resolution directing the effort.

#### 2018 Survey Instructions

Annually, NASDPTS requests that each state choose a single day on which to have school bus operators (public and contracted) observe and report any instances of motorists illegally passing their school buses. It is recommended that the survey be conducted on a state-designated, representative school day from March 1 to May 31. State directors are encouraged to enlist assistance from their state associations as needed.
