As a result, MADD Minnesota now has 7 beautiful quilts that commemorate the lives of those who were killed or injured by drunk driving. Each panel was lovingly created by friends and families from all over the state of Minnesota. Each small heart was stitched by hand by Sharon and Doris's Quilting Circle. Fabric was donated by JoAnn Fabrics and Lynne Goughler in memory of her parents.

The quilt program went by the wayside for a few years and we would now like to offer quilt squares again to families who would like to commemorate their loved ones in this way. Quilts are available for display at local events and in the state office.
