What is Safety Town

- Safety Town, a miniature city layout built to the scale of a small child
- Founded in 1937 after a child was struck and killed by a car on his way to school
- In 1964, the program was expanded and updated as a comprehensive safety education program



State Fair

- Buildings, vehicles, signals, signs
- Safe Routes to School curriculum
- Used tape to replicate sidewalks, lanes of traffic and railroad crossing

- Teaching youth to walk and ride safely
- Instilling positive behaviors at an early age
- Traffic safety culture
