Unmanned aerial drones (UAD) use software instead of traditional survey equipment to help clear the roadway quickly and to make the roadways safer for the traveling public – and for the responders. What is required for a CRS to be called to a scene? When and where can the UAD fly? See the differences between the "old" scene diagrams and the "new."

 servers aware of the civil and criminal penalties. The train-the-trainer is available to law
 enforcement, public health organizations as well as Alcohol & Drug community coalitions.
