A crash reconstruction aims to document how a crash occurred and determine which factors caused the crash. While most crashes are caused by driver (or pedestrian or bicyclist) errors, a crash reconstruction can also assess the role that vehicle defects or roadway design may have played. Suppose a vehicle defect or roadway design is determined to be a contributing factor. In that case, that information is forwarded to the appropriate local, state or federal authority,

so that vehicle design or roadway design changes can be addressed.
